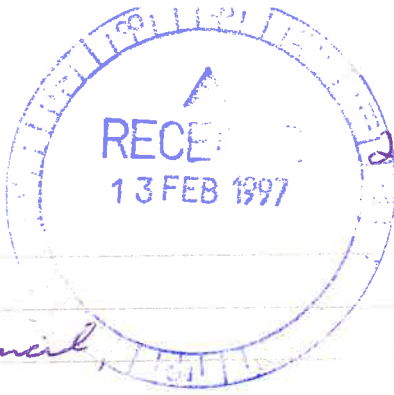

Information you seek can be provided by the Forestry Commission of N.S.W. - Neenah State Forest No. 748 - 9 mile plantation area (which in all respect, is nothing but Vacant Crown Land) and there is no likelihood of any plantation or development work.
